

Course Description:

This is a high school level class with quizzes and a semester exam. Expect daily work to take one to one-and-a-half hours per day. Expectations are that students turn in work completed on time, willing to ask questions over concepts they need help with, and that parents will be involved with the process (this is where the recommended solution key is helpful), and making sure that their students are keeping up with schedules. The homework is heavily weighted to stress the importance of daily practice with math. Many lectures will be assigned to watch on YouTube, so internet access is a must. Grades will be recorded on TEAMS.

- Statistics and Probability
