Course Description: This full year of high-school-level Advanced Spanish Studies will help the student continue to develop proficiency in the Spanish language. The class will be "full speed ahead" and entail:

- A High School or college textbook (i.e., Spanish Now I/II, or BJU ;Nuevos Amigos! Level II, etc.)
- Frequent quizzes and tests
- Up to one hour of daily homework
- Grades will be given at this level.

Since our homeschool co-op only meets once per week throughout the "school year", it is absolutely necessary that students be in attendance. If a student must miss class, assignments must be made up in a timely manner. Language is best learned when heard and practiced daily, so it is very important that students spend time every day practicing and studying Spanish. Without attendance or diligence in studying, the student will not succeed. Many colleges are now requiring high school language study, so please encourage a persistent and positive attitude. Stay on top of things and we'll all have a successful year learning Spanish!
